Certificate concerning participation in project Education for Entrepreneurship and Innovation

This is to certificate Viktoriya Loboda's active involvement in the project Education for Entrepreneurship and Innovation (E4E&I) during the years 2012-14.

Project Education for Entrepreneurship and Innovation started in the fall of 2012, ran for two years and was concluded in the fall of 2014. The project was financed by the Swedish Institute, and run by Stockholm University. The aim of the project was to stimulate and improve entrepreneurship in higher education. The project was run as a partnership between Stockholm University, Ayond, Ukrainian Distance Learning System, SoftServe, Tbilisi State University and Georgia Technical University.

The project reached the following results:

- More than 300 students concluded an entrepreneurship education
- 14 students concluded an international entrepreneurship internship
- 6 companies started, 1 has already been sold, several more in starting-up phase
- Entrepreneurship courses started at three partner Universities
- Engaged innovative SME-ecosystem surrounding the new courses
- Established network of engaged researchers, teachers and entrepreneurs

Viktoriya Loboda was active in the project in many different roles - project management, research, report writing as well as teaching the Entrepreneurship and Innovation e-course.
