CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS, ARTICLE PUBLICATION, FEES

Abstracts are invited to address the above-mentioned and related themes. Abstracts should not exceed 2 pages, format A4. Please use MS Word for Windows and Times New Roman, font size - 12; line spacing - 1,5; margins: left - 2.5 cm; right, top, and bottom - 2 cm. The abstract should contain the following parts: setting the problem, main research questions (100-200 words); methods, research instruments used (100-200 words); conclusions, expected outcomes or findings (200-300 words); references. File name: Abstract_Surname. **Conference participation and publication of abstracts (electronic version)** for foreign participants **are free of charge.**

Abstracts will be published in the **Conference Proceedings** in author's edition and will be available online **prior** to the Conference.

Publication of articles in the academic journal "**Visnyk of Lviv University. Pedagogical series**", **category B,** will be available after the conference. The articles are to be submitted via e-mail to <u>conf.lnu.2021@gmail.com</u> with the subject "**Conference October 28-29, 2021**". Articles should not exceed 10 pages with tables, illustrations and references. Please use MS Word for Windows and TNR. It should be typed on A4 paper, with the pages numbered consecutively; the margins - upper, lower, right, left - 2 cm, font - Times New Roman, Cyr, size 14, plain style, without hyphenation and tabs, line spacing – 1,5; indentation of the first line - 1.25 cm, paragraph alignment - in width.

The author(s) of the article bears full **responsibility** for the accuracy, editing and recency of their contribution, accurate citation of the sources and references to them. Only sources cited in the text must be listed in the list of references, in alphabetical order, at the end of the manuscript. Special attention should be paid to the required punctuation: serial number in the list of references and pages of the citation, which shall be placed in square brackets, e.g. [4, p. 32]. If the author uses references to several sources, then this should be stated as follows, e.g. [4; 32]. Articles without the references will not be reviewed by the editorial board.

Structure of the article:

1) manuscript title (maximum 15 words); 2) name, surname of the author(s); 3) full name of the educational institution where the author works, institution's address, author's work telephone number and e-mail address; 4) abstract of the article in English (if the manuscript is in English) up to 1800 characters, including keywords); 5) keywords in English (6-8 words); 6) text of the article; 7) references; 8) the title of the article (if the manuscript is in English) and hereinafter referred to as positions 2-5 in Ukrainian. The abstract in Ukrainian should be at least 1800 characters long (about 320 words), including keywords. Articles submitted in violation of the above requirements will not be accepted for consideration Each article will be reviewed by the editorial board. Publication fee in "Visnyk of Lviv University. Pedagogical series" is 50 Euro per 10-page article, each extra page will be charged additionally (5 Euro per page).
